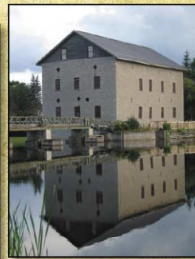

## Historic Site of Red Fife Wheat



The Village is the site of David Fife's 1825 log cabin. An immigrant from Scotland, David Fife began a horticultural experiment which led to the discovery of Red Fife wheat in 1842. By 1870, Red Fife wheat was well established in southern Ontario, the northern United States and the Canadian Prairies because of its high yield and excellent bread making qualities.



## Facility Rentals

The Glen Alda Church and Lang Grist Mill provide a tranquil location for weddings, services and photographs. Built in 1898, the Church seats 65 and boasts an 1880's Doherty pump organ. The Village also offers a unique setting for corporate events, birthday parties, family reunions and other group activities.
