The first 200 vehicles to enter will receive a complimentary dash plaque as a souvenir of their participation. Visitors will enjoy fantastic music from the 50s to the 80s by DJ Del and Jenny Jams while they admire the vehicles and cast their vote for their favourite. Inside the Village, learn more about how transportation has changed over the years. Enjoy free horse-drawn wagon rides through the historic village.
