# **22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Father's Day Smoke & Steam Show** **Sunday, June 17 ~ 10 am to 4 pm**

**Lang, ON-** Treat dad to a Father's Day filled with tractors and power equipment with the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Father's Day Smoke & Steam Show at Lang Pioneer Village Museum! On Sunday, June 17 from 10 am to 4 pm, Lang's 2018 event season kicks off with the largest show of its kind in the Kawarthas.

Watch as local collectors bring to life some of the oldest antique tractors and steam engines around as they compete for over 20 awards including Best Unique Exhibit, Best Display and Lang Pioneer Village's Choice Award. The tractor games, including lawn tractor races, begin at 12 noon. Watch as tractors try to balance on a tilted platform as fast as possible or maneuver through an obstacle course while balancing a tin can on a stick. View displays of smoke and steam collectibles, hit and miss engines, antique tool collections and more. Meet the 2018 Smoke & Steam Show Ambassador Kristyn Longhurst and new for this year, be sure to check out the vintage farm trucks and treat Dad to a delicious serving of poutine from Reggie's Hot Grill Poutine station! Also new this year is the Peterborough County Agricultural Wall of Fame Exhibit in the new Peterborough County Agricultural Heritage Building.

Hop on board a tractor and wagon ride and tour the village in style. Throughout the Village, learn about the many ways power was generated in the 1800s. See the Shingle Mill in full operation powered by antique engines. Discover the power of air and heat at the Blacksmith Shop. Learn about steam and horse power at the South Lake School House. See broad axe hand-hewing demonstrations, natural dyeing demonstrations, Jacquard loom demonstrations, pipe making demonstrations and more. Take some time to pause and enjoy music by Nassau Mills on the Weaver Shop porch or a delicious treat and cold drink in the Keene Hotel.

The day will conclude with a huge tractor parade through the village beginning at 3:15 pm.

Come on out to the 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Father's Day Smoke & Steam Show this Sunday from 10 am to 4 pm for a day that everyone is sure to enjoy! Admission is \$15 for adults, \$10 for students and seniors (60+), \$7 for youths (ages 5-14) and free for children under 5. Family admission is also available for \$40 and includes 2 adults and up to 4 youths (ages 5-14). All taxes included.
