22nd Annual Transportation Day Car & Motorcycle Show Sunday, July 15 ~ 10 am to 4 pm

Lang, ON- Come vote for your favourite car and motorcycle this Sunday at the 22nd Annual Transportation Day Car & Motorcycle Show at Lang Pioneer Village Museum. On July 15 from 10 am to 4 pm, view antique and classic cars and vintage motorcycles brought by car and motorcycle enthusiasts from across Ontario. New this year, we have vintage bicycle enthusiasts bringing their rare vintage bicycles which will be on display in the Peterborough County Agricultural Heritage Building.

Participant registration runs from 8 am to 12 noon with a \$10 registration fee that includes admission into the Village. The first 200 vehicles to enter will receive a complimentary dash plaque as a souvenir of their participation. MC Courtney Bell of Country 105 will be awarding over 50 trophies including the coveted People's Choice and Lang's Choice. Visitors will enjoy fantastic music from the 50s to the 80s by DJ Del and Jenny Jams while they admire the vehicles and cast their vote for their favourite.

Inside the Village, learn more about how transportation has changed over the years. Enjoy free horse-drawn wagon rides through the historic village. Cool down in the Milburn House with a sample of a refreshing historic beverage called the "Strawberry Shrub". In Aabnaabin Camp, learn about the importance of the canoe which was developed over thousands of years by the Indigenous people of North America. See demonstrations on the Jacquard

loom, the Grandmother of modern computing, log hand-hewing demonstrations and more. Stop at the Keene Hotel for a delicious treat and cold refreshment and the Cheese Factory for fresh Empire Cheese curds. In the Transportation Barn you will see 19th century modes of transportation such as sleighs, wagons and milk carts. Kids, make a galloping horse flip book to take home!

Parking for the event is available at the Lang soccer field. Transportation will be provided throughout the day between the Village and parking area.

Don't miss the 22nd Annual Transportation Day Car & Motorcycle Show this Sunday, July 15 at Lang Pioneer Village Museum. Admission is \$15 for adults, \$10 for students and seniors (60+), \$7 for youths (ages 5-14) and free for children under 5. Family admission is also available for \$40 and includes 2 adults and up to 4 youths (ages 5-14). All taxes included.
