## **Harvest Time in the Village Pre-Booked Drive-Thru Tour** **Sunday, October 4 ~ 10 am to 4 pm**

**Lang, ON** – Come experience the beauty of the historic Village in the fall with Harvest Time in the Village at Lang Pioneer Village Museum. On Sunday, October 4, travel back in time to the autumn of years gone by, all from the comfort of your own vehicle. From 10 am to 4 pm, Lang Pioneer Village Museum will be offering a drive-thru tour of the Village with snapshots of settler life at harvest time, when preparations for the long winter ahead were in full swing.

With safety measures as a result of COVID-19 still an integral part of our day-to-day lives, this tour is a glimpse into the Museum's beloved Applefest demonstrations and activities as a completely hands-off and visually-rich experience. Visitors will slowly drive through the historic Village where costumed interpreters will be demonstrating traditional settler harvest activities. The tour is expected to take approximately 30-45 minutes. There is an optional audio portion of the tour. Visitors will be provided with a link to an audio component which will enhance the demonstrations that they will witness as they tour the Village. Those interested can access the audio on their personal devices via YouTube. The Village has public WiFi which can be accessed on the day of the event. Those wishing to experience the tour visually only are welcome to do so. Local traditional musicians will be providing musical entertainment along the route.

The cost to attend is \$25 per carload. Tickets must be purchased in advance on the Museum's online shop at <https://lang-pioneer-village-museum.myshopify.com/>.
