Lang, ON – Experience the charm of the historic village in the evening with Village by Lantern Light taking place Friday & Saturday, September 16 & 17 at Lang Pioneer Village Museum. From 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm each evening, the village will be illuminated by the soft glow of lantern and candle light providing visitors a different twilight-to-nightfall perspective of the historic village.

During this family-friendly event, guests will learn how settler families spent their time after dark, exploring themes from entertainment to education to preparing for bed. Enjoy a tractor and wagon ride through the Village under the evening sky. Discover how the Tinsmith influenced nighttime preparations. Learn about the activities families performed in the evening to prepare for the next day. See demonstrations of various

traditional crafts and trades such as weaving, tin smithing, printing, carpentry, and more. Be entertained by traditional melodies as a local musician serenades you from the Weaver's Shop porch each evening. Make sure you stop by the Keene Hotel for a treat or refreshment to enjoy under the stars.

Experience the charm of an evening in the historic village with Village by Lantern Light, September 16 & 17 at Lang Pioneer Village Museum. Admission is \$15 for adults, \$10 for students and seniors (60+), \$7 for youths (ages 5-14) and free for children under 5. Family admission is also available for \$40 and includes 2 adults and up to 4 youths (ages 5-14). Visitors may purchase admission in advance via the Museum's online shop, but advance purchase is not required. Guests are encouraged to bring a flashlight for added visibility in the dark and dress for the weather as this event takes place mostly outdoors.
