Successful applicants will need to attend a planning meeting with museum staff (date and time TBD), and the Smoke and Steam Show event on **Sunday**, **June 16**, **2024**, **from 9 am to 4 pm** to assist in the activities of the day; and will get the opportunity to see and be involved in a successful tourism event at one of the region's premiere attractions.

The Elements of the Program Include:

Event Coordination: Working with the Museum's staff and event volunteers to oversee a range of activities on the event day.

Behind the Scenes Education: Providing a "behind the scenes" look at event coordination at a living history museum and tourist attraction.

Social Program: Ability to network with other peers in the industry, and community members, as well as to make contact with facility operators in the tourism and museum industry.
