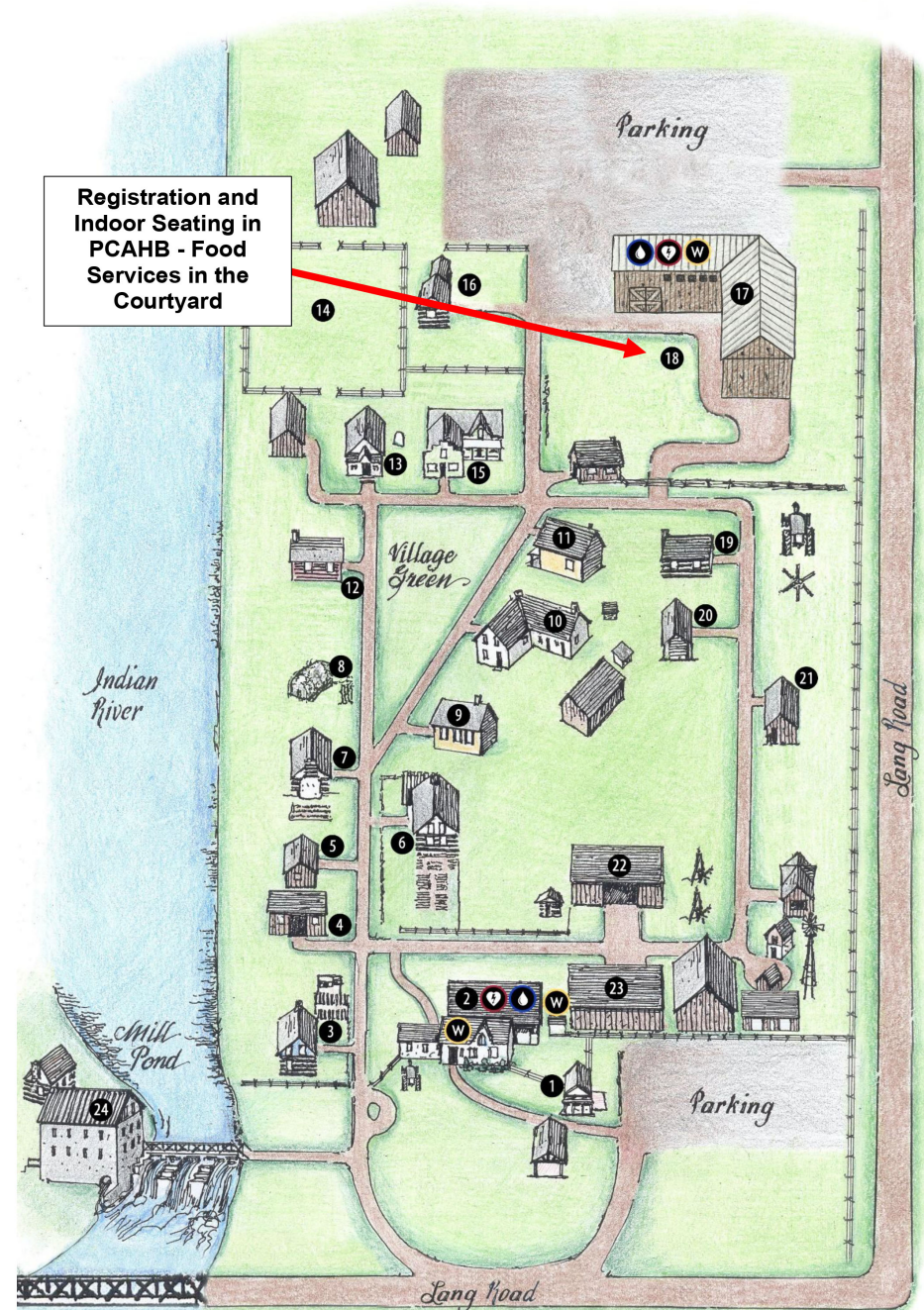
**New Exhibit - Less Work, More Play Exhibit**

There is much to see and do on site today – this is just a snapshot of what you can expect!

1. **Admissions**- Purchase tickets!
2. **Visitor Centre & Museum Shop**- Start your trip at our exhibit Aabnaabin: Looking Back To Where We Come From.
3. **Milburn House**- Learn about the phonograph and see how basketry is created.
4. **Hastie Carpenter Shop**- Discover about how the Carpenter went about making sleighs and wagons for transport.
5. **Tinsmith Shop**- Watch as the Tinsmith turns a piece of tin into functional pieces that helped people travel at night.
6. **Fitzpatrick House**- See the spinning wheel in motion!
7. **Fife Cabin**- Find out about the various modes of transportation used on the journey from Europe to their new home.
8. **Aabnaabin Camp**- Learn about Birch Bark Canoes and see how Indigenous people travelled on the waterways at the beginning of the century.
9. **Register Print Shop**- "News travels Fast!" See how travel advertisements of the past were made and how newspapers kept people informed of things from around the world.
10. **Keene Hotel**- A delicious selection of traditional baked goods and drinks for sale, including: butter tarts, fruit tarts, sausage rolls, and heritage soda. Head upstairs to write a letter and drop it off at the General Store.
11. **Menie General Store**- Featuring a selection of old-fashioned candy for sale. The transportation of mail was an essential service – come learn about the Post Office!
12. **Douro Town Hall** – Sign the Suffragette's petition and join in on the fun of the "Sisters of Suffragette" performances.
13. **Glen Alda Church**- Take a break from traveling and enjoy the organ music.
14. **Back Field** – Peterborough City County Paramedics display
15. **S. W. Lowry Weaver Shop & Jacquard Loom Interpretive Centre**- Try your hand at weaving! See the punch card machine in action.
16. **Ayotte Cabin**- "Less Work, More Play" exhibit created by students from Fleming College's Museum Management and Curatorship program.
17. **Peterborough County Agricultural Heritage Building (PCAHB)**- Washrooms & Agricultural Wall of Fame Gallery. *Great Hall: All Aboard!* Check out the Peterborough Model Railroaders display. Car registration location, here until Noon!
18. **Courtyard**- Ben's Kettle Corn popping up fresh kettle corn, pancakes on a stick by Call Creations, and the Keene Lions Club food trailer serving hot dogs and hamburgers. DJ, MC and Registration & 50/50 tickets from Noon onward.
19. **South Lake School**- Take part in a lesson on pioneer travel and transportation. Put your skills to the test in a lively spelling bee challenge! Craft Area – Make a paper plane and fly it down the runway.
20. **Cheese Factory**- Learn how cheese was made in the 1800's. Fresh Empire cheese curd, fresh bread, and pickles on a stick for sale.
21. **Shingle Mill**- See how shingles are made! 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM.
22. **Transportation Barn**- View the many types of 19<sup>th</sup> century vehicles used through various seasons to transport goods, people and the mail.
23. **Trades Barn**- Check out the tools of the trades
24. **Lang Grist Mill and Miller's Cabin**- Visit the Miller and discover how wheat is ground into flour.
